



REPORT INTERNET SCAMS

We suggest reporting "phishing" or "spoofed" e-mails to the following groups:

- Forward the e-mail to reportphishing@antiphishing.org
- Forward the e-mail to the Federal Trade Commission at spam@uce.gov
- Forward the e-mail to the "abuse" e-mail address at the company that is being spoofed
- When forwarding spoofed messages, always include the entire original e-mail with its original header information intact.
- Notify the Internet Crime Complaint Center (IC3), a partnership of the Federal Bureau of Investigation (FBI) and the National White-Collar Crime Center (NW3C), by filing a complaint on their Web site at www.ic3.gov
- If you believe you have received a suspicious or fraudulent email that appears to be from Velocity Community Credit Union, do not reply or click on any of its links, contact any phone numbers, or otherwise provide any personal information. Please forward it immediately to phishemail@velocitycommunity.org. If you have responded to a Web scam and provided any confidential information, please Contact Us immediately.
